Puerto Rico will run out of disaster nutrition assistance funds on March 1st, if Congress does not approve additional funds. Thus, we fully support the efforts made by the Coalition for Food Security and urge you to ensure that an allocation of \$600 million dollars in additional NAP funds for Puerto Rico is included in HJ Res. 31 this week.
