Mr. Jaime Plá Cortés is executive president of the Puerto Rico Hospital Association, a non-profit organization founded in 1942 that represents hospitals, other public and private health institutions and health care professionals in Puerto Rico. Mr. Plá is a recognized health care leader in Puerto Rico, currently presiding the governing board of the Carlos Albizu University, president of the board of directors of Servicios de Salud Episcopales, as well as having served in the governing board of Servicios de Salud Episcopales and administrator of Saint Luke's Episcopal Hospital. Mr. Plá is past president of the Association of Health Services Administrators and past president of the Puerto Rico Healthcare Quality Association.

As executive president of the Puerto Rico Hospital Association, Mr. Plá leads efforts to achieve parity for Puerto Rico under federal health care programs, working together with the government of Puerto Rico and other stakeholders to represent the needs of Puerto Rico in Washington.

Mr. Plá is also president of two medical equipment and pharmaceutical companies, EPC & Nutrix.

For the first time in the history of the Puerto Rico Hospital Association, Mr. Plá was reelected to serve a second consecutive term as president of the Association. Mr. Plá holds a Masters degree in Health Services Administration from the University of Puerto Rico.
