

The Puerto Rico Chamber of Commerce carries out its daily work consulting problems and situations that directly or indirectly affect the private sector of the economy with the Working Committees. The function of the working committees in this effort is of vital importance, so that not only the Executive Committee but also the Board of Directors and the President can receive counsel and advice from the various business sectors. This allows the organization to submit necessary proposals to the corresponding authorities.

All members of the Puerto Rico Chamber of Commerce and their designated representatives are eligible to form part of the Working Committee of their choice. The President of the Puerto Rico Chamber of Commerce will designate the chairpersons of every Committee, who will occupy their position for one year, and will inform them of matters that will constitute the work agenda and priorities for the fiscal year.

Chair persons will concentrate their efforts on these priorities and will recruit volunteer resources in order to facilitate the culmination of their agenda during the fiscal year. If culmination is not possible in that time period, they will submit pertinent recommendations at the end of their terms in order to allow proper continuity of such efforts in subsequent fiscal years.

Chairpersons of the Working Committees may submit additional recommendations at any time during the year in order to add to the work plan, provided they are accompanied with adequate justification defining the problem or matter that the chair deems worthy of consideration, the solutions to be offered and the benefit to be produced.
