



# **Provide Coverage of Hepatitis-C Drugs**

# Provide Medicare Part B Premium Coverage for Dual Eligibles

There are approximately
282,000 Medicaid and Medicare
eligible in Puerto Rico that pay the
Medicare Part B premium
out-of-pocket.







# Puerto Rico Poverty Level Adjustment

Puerto Rico has the authority to modify the Puerto Rico poverty level (PRPL) on which income requirements for Medicaid is based.
