


Environmental Workforce Development and Job Training Program

Glorymar joined PathStone on March 2010 as Placement & Career Services Developer in the Pathways out of Poverty Grant. This program main goal was to serve dropouts and individuals with criminal record and introduce them to emerging opportunities for employment in the Green Industry. For the last grant year she was promoted to Training & Employment Manager. This grant successfully ended in 2014, exceeding all program goals. Therefore, stepping into the role of Regional Administrator for the National Farmworkers Job Program (NFJP). Glorymar has been an advocate for Environmental Workforce Development. In 2015 she achieved the first PathStone Project funded by EPA where residents of the south area of Puerto Rico had the opportunity to be trained and placed into environmental jobs related to asbestos and lead removal. These experiences gave her a deep appreciation of how non-profits seek to improve the quality of life and how motivated people can contribute to build a better and resilient Puerto Rico.

2017 Minimum of 3 Certifications:

Core includes 72 hours of instruction and certifications in HAZWOPER, Pesticide Safety, Forklift operation and OSHA 10-hour general industry.

2019 Minimum of 5 Certifications:

Core includes 79 hours of instruction and certifications in HAZWOPER, Pesticide Safety, Forklift operation, OSHA 10-hour general industry, CPR, and AED.

*An additional 152 hours of instruction and certifications/licenses offered in asbestos remediation, lead abatement, CDL Class A with hazmat.


