**Advertisement for Bids**

In accordance with act 125 of May 7, 1942, as amended, and Regulation 7496 of PRPA Bids and Request for Proposals, the Puerto Rico Ports Authority (PRPA) is requesting competitive bids from contractors, for the construction of the following project:

**Entrance Road (Boxer Drive) Reconstruction at Ceiba International Airport (RVR), Ceiba, PR**

This project includes, but is not limited to, the following items: The project consists of removing approximately 13,037 square meters of existing pavement and base material. The new construction will consist of two (2) inches of bituminous surface course overlaid on four (4) inches of bituminous base, six (6) inches of aggregate base course, grading class A, on top of twenty (20) inches of sub-base course; minor drainage improvements, lighting improvements, and new signage and marking along the proposed access road, all in accordance to plans and specifications.

Bidders shall submit Proposals in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Contract Documents, until 1:30 PM (PR Time) on **September 29, 2011**. A **non-compulsory pre-bid** conference will be held at 1:30 PM (PR Time) on **September 13, 2011** at the Directorate of Engineering, Construction and Environmental Affairs Conference Room. Date limit for submittal of questions is **September 22, 2011, 3:00 P.M.**

The Drawings, Specifications and other Contract documents for this project, may be obtained at the Engineering Bureau of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority. Central Office, Phone Number (787) 729-8832, 8829, until 48 hours prior to opening the bids by paying a non refundable amount of fifty dollars (**\$50.00**) in cash or certified check to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority for each set of documents.

All bids received, will be publicly opened and read aloud by the Board of Awards at the Conference Room of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority Central Office at Isla Grande, San Juan, Puerto Rico at the same day of the Bid Opening of the project.

The Bidder must comply with all Federal regulations, including, but not limited, to minimum wage rates and EEO Requirements as established by the U.S. Department of Labor and with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) Requirements of 49 CFR Part 23. In addition, it should comply with all applicable local, state and federal regulations specially those imposed by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

The successful bidder must submit to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority the required bonds, insurance, policies, certificate of having filed an income tax return statement to the Puerto Rico Treasury Department for the last five years, certificate of debts to the Government of Puerto Rico, certificate of payment of property taxes, certificate of payment of unemployment insurance, temporal incapacity and social security for drivers, etc., and shall execute the construction contract within ten (10) working days after the date of the Notice of Award. The Payment Bond and the Performance Bond shall be in an amount not less than one hundred (100%) percent of the total value of the contract awarded to him and shall be executed with a satisfactory surety or sureties for the full and faithful performance of the work.
