Chamber's Donohue Urges President Against Restrictive Immigration Actions

Yesterday, U.S. Chamber CEO Tom Donohue sent a letter to President Donald Trump urging against restrictive immigration policies.

"As the economy rebounds, American businesses will need assurances that they can meet all their workforce needs. To that end, it is crucial that they have access to talent both domestically and from around the world," wrote Donohue. "Policies that would, for example, impose wide-ranging bans on the entry of nonimmigrant workers or impose burdensome new regulatory requirements on businesses that employ foreign nationals would undermine that access to talent, and, in the process, undercut our economy's ability to grow and create jobs."

"If these American businesses are unable to bring needed expertise into the country, investments and research may not happen, to the detriment of American workers and our economy," he added.
