

Federal AI Guidance Will Keep U.S. on the Leading Edge

Last week, a bipartisan group of House members sent a letter to the Office of Management and Budget urging the administration to [expedite Artificial Intelligence \(AI\) guidance](#).

Why it matters: The guidance “is important in addressing the opportunities and risks posed by AI implementation and ensuring that a consistent framework exists,” the letter states.

It will encompass “a complete government approach that will ensure the AI systems are built and deployed in a responsible and trustworthy manner, which will subsequently be used as a benchmark for federal agencies when considering future regulatory actions related to AI.”
