

Fast Forward Looks at Future of Food and Housing

Innovation follows crises: Speakers at Food Forward talked about access to nutrition, food waste, and how COVID-19 is changing how we eat at home. Blue Apron CEO Linda Findley Kozlowski shared how the pandemic has changed how the company communicates with its customers, and how it has affected their supply chain.

In today's Housing Forward: CEO of Habitat for Humanity Jonathan Reckford spoke about how the pandemic has exacerbated the affordable housing crisis and noted the “k-shaped” recovery Americans are experiencing. “The economy has been pretty good for half of our society, for those who have assets, who can work from home, and have knowledge-based jobs,” he said. “But the situation is dire for many service workers who are at risk both to health care and economic vulnerability.”
