Today, the U.S. Chamber led a Digital Day of Action asking Congress to expand Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) eligibility to local and state chambers, industry associations, and local tourism groups that are critical to our local communities.



These organizations comprise the fabric of our communities. They are the protectors, promoters, and support systems for Main Street. But unlike most other small nonprofits they have been prohibited from accessing PPP support due to a unique tax code classification.

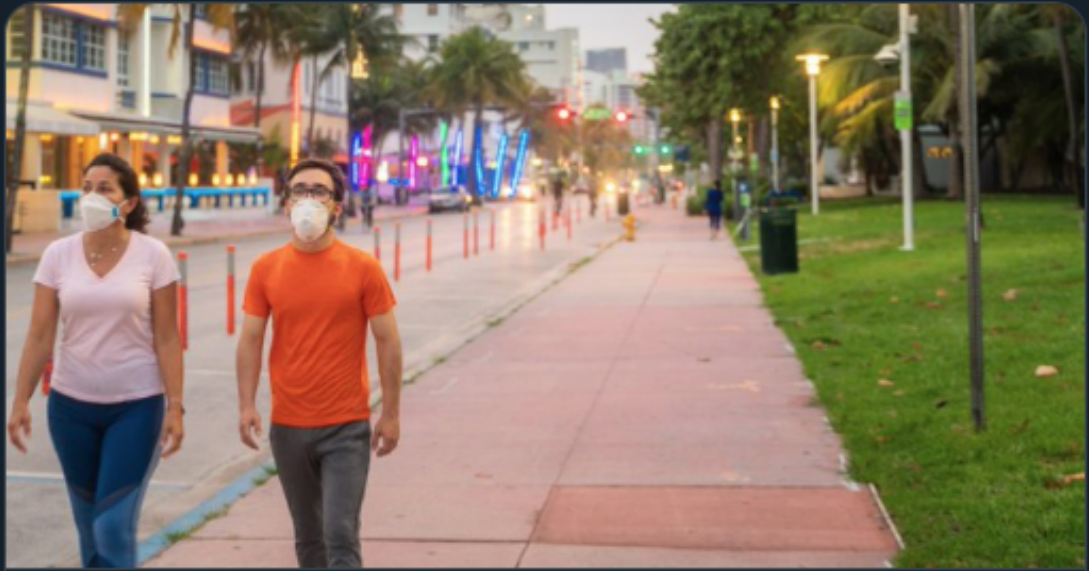
