Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Businesses. Self-Certification

A contracting officer can also set-aside acquisitions for Veteran Owned Small Businesses (VOSB) or Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Businesses (SDVOSB) .

- SDVOSB - To participate in this type of set-aside, such businesses must be at least 51% owned and controlled by a service-disabled veteran and the daily management operations of the concern must be controlled by a service-disabled veteran or caregiver. And, they must be a small business. And, they must be a small business.
- VOSB - such businesses must be at least 51% owned and controlled by a veteran and the daily management operations of the concern must be controlled by a veteran.

Self Certified except for VA Contracts *

Eligibility – WOSB Program

- Meet **small business size standard** for primary NAICS code and contract
- At least **51% unconditionally and directly owned by women** who are **U.S. citizens***
- The woman must manage the **day-to-day operations**
- The woman must make the **long-term decisions** for the business
- A woman must **hold highest officer position**
- The woman must work at the business **full-time during normal working hours**
- No minimum amount of time** the business has been operational

Eligibility Requirements for EDWOSBs

Meets the criteria as a WOSB (on previous page) PLUS:

Personal net worth (assets minus liabilities) **is less than \$750,000** excluding:

- Ownership in business and primary personal residence
- Income reinvested or used to pay taxes of business
- Funds reinvested in IRA or other retirement account*
- Transferred assets within two years if to or on behalf of immediate family member for select purposes**

Adjusted gross income average over three years is \$350,000 or less excluding:

- Income reinvested or used to pay taxes of business

Fair market value of assets is \$6 million or less excluding:

- Funds reinvested in IRA or other official retirement account

* Must be IRA or other official retirement account that is unavailable until retirement age without significant penalty

** Select purposes are for that individual's education, medical expenses or other essential support or to family member in recognition of special event

Note: SBA will look at a spouse's finances if the spouse has a role in the WOSB/EDWOSB, has lent money to or provided financial support (including credit or guarantee of loan) to the business. SBA may also look at spouse's finances if both spouses are in same or similar line of business and businesses share names, websites, equipment and employees.

CREATE USER ACCOUNT

Your CCR username will not work in SAM. You will need a new SAM User Account to register or update your entity records. You will also need to create a SAM User Account if you are a government official and need to create Exclusions or search for FOUO information.

REGISTER/UPDATE ENTITY

You can register your Entity (business, individual, or government agency) to do business with the Federal Government. If you are interested in registering or updating your Entity, you must first create a user account.

SEARCH RECORDS

All entity records from CCR/FedReg and ORCA and exclusion records from EPLS, active or expired, were moved to SAM. You can search these records and new ones created in SAM. If you are a government user logged in with your SAM user account, you will automatically have access to FOUO information.

FORMER CCR REGISTRANTS

If you had an active record in CCR, you have an active record in SAM. You do not need to do anything in SAM at this time, unless a change in your business circumstances requires updates to your Entity record(s) in order for you to be paid or to receive an award or you need to renew your Entity(s) prior to its expiration. SAM will send notifications to the registered user via email 60, 30, and 15 days prior to expiration of the Entity. To update or renew your Entity records(s) in SAM you will need to create a SAM User Account and link it to your migrated Entity records. You do not need a user account to search for registered entities in SAM by typing the DUNS number or business name into the search box.

8(a) and HUBZone: Programs that Require Formal Certification (preapproval) by SBA

Both programs provide eligibility for Sole source:

- 8(a) - Socially and economically disadvantaged firms enrolled in a 9-year business development program. Eligible to receive competitive and 'sole source' contract awards. www.sba.gov/8abd
Up to \$6.5M for (mfg) and Up to \$4.0M for (non-mfg)
- HUBZone - Small businesses, owned and controlled by US Citizens, community Development Corps, Indian tribes with its principal office located in areas identified as historically underutilized business zones, and with 35% of employees coming from HUBZones, eligible to receive competitive and 'sole source' awards. www.sba.gov/hubzone

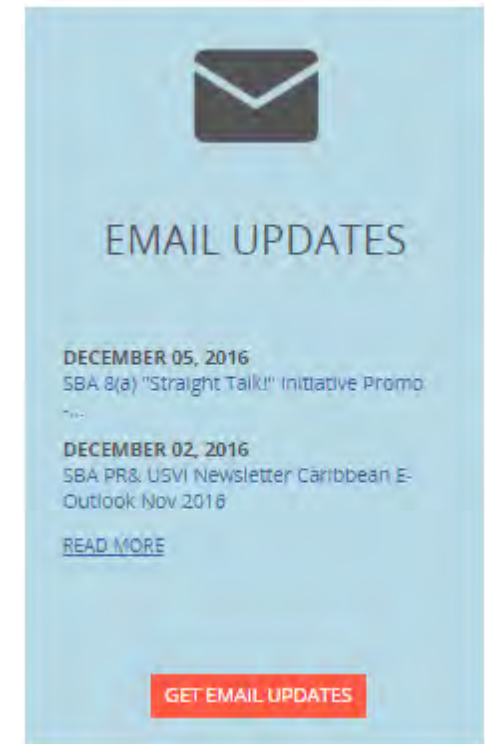

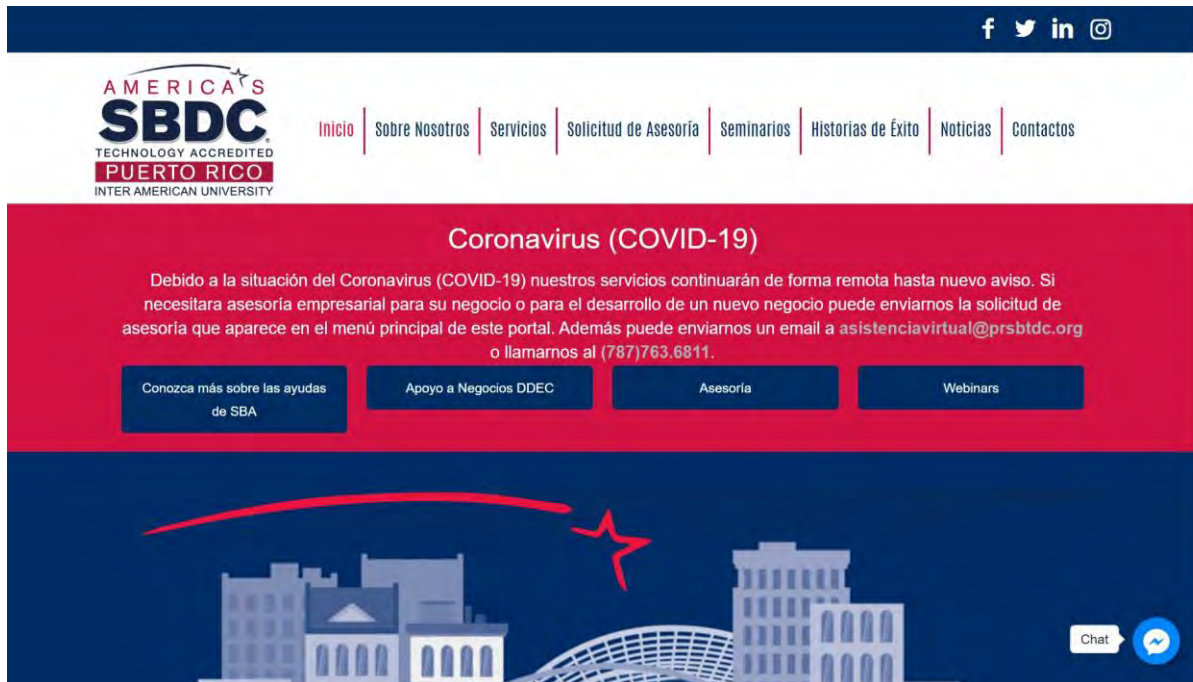
