Operation: Warp Speed Leader Sees Vaccine Distribution for Essential Workers, Elderly Starting Next Week



During this week's *Path Forward*, hosted by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Foundation, U.S. Chamber President Suzanne Clark spoke with General Paul Ostrowski, director of supply, production and distribution for Operation Warp Speed.

Big picture: Ostrowski said Operation Warp Speed is in good shape in trying to reach their goal of 300 million doses as soon as possible.

"20 million doses were allocated to jurisdictions by the end of 2020," said Ostrowski.
"The uptake is a delayed aspect of that...you have to have the supply out there first before you get the uptake."

Coming up: Next week, we'll start to see vaccines becoming available in pharmacies, as well as other public health centers, for the general population 75 years and older and essential workers.

• "70-80% of Americans, hopefully, will do the right thing and stand up to the plate and get their vaccination, so that we can keep us all safe and secure," Ostrowski said.
