

Middle Market Business Leaders Anticipate Policy Changes Under Biden Administration

Senior executives at middle market businesses are generally optimistic about the American economy under President Joe Biden, even as they expect substantial shifts in certain policies, according to the [RSM and U.S. Chamber of Commerce Middle Market Business Index Election Pulse survey](#).

The survey, taken from Nov. 19 to Dec. 2, 2020, captures the dynamic changes taking place across the middle market and the broader economy.

Key Takeaways:

- **46%** said that they were much more optimistic or somewhat more optimistic when asked how their expectations for the economy had changed due to the election, while **36%** said they were somewhat more pessimistic or much more pessimistic.
- **Executives anticipated substantial changes** in the government's approach to a range of issues, including the tax code; reversal of tariffs and trade policies; and reinstating regulations in areas like the environment, labor, health care, consumer financial protections, and immigration.
