UPS is proud to commit to Rally For Recovery. As a company that has played a key role in fighting COVID-19 since Day 1, UPS is focused on accelerating access to vaccines so we can return to work and school, reopen safely, and ultimately defeat the pandemic.

With more vaccines having been approved for emergency use, UPS is helping in several ways. The company has leveraged its world-wide network and infrastructure to deliver more than 250 million total doses to more than 90 countries so far, with a target of over 1 billion doses by the end of the year. UPS is also lending support services such as providing portable freezers for remote locations and producing dry ice to keep vaccines cold. Through the use of its innovative healthcare tracking technology and global healthcare command center, UPS has delivered 99.99% on-time performance and vaccine temperature integrity throughout the delivery process.

UPS is also working tirelessly to educate its employees about the vaccine. Their “It’s Your Shot” campaign is designed to provide employees with up-to-date, state-specific information on vaccine availability, while company leaders and staff have also created testimonials to encourage co-workers to get the shot. The company is also piloting a vaccine clinic in Chicago, its largest ground distribution center in the U.S., and exploring the use of mobile vaccine clinics across the country.

Given the global nature of the pandemic, UPS is lending a hand to areas without as much access to the vaccine. From distribution via drone in Ghana to worldwide partnerships with the international organizations involved in COVAX, UPS is taking the lead in getting the vaccine out to the most underserved communities and remote locations. Foundation pledging more than \$1 million in funding, in-kind transportation and technical expertise. Since the pandemic began, The UPS Foundation has provided more than \$22 million in COVID-19 related aid to more than 115 countries.
