## **Employers, Elected Officials, and Community Leaders Join Forces to Combat High Unemployment Rates for Military Spouses**

First Lady Jill Biden provided keynote remarks to more than 1,800 virtual attendees at the U.S. Chamber Foundation's <u>Hiring Our Heroes</u>' Fifth Annual Military Spouse Employment Summit last week. The summit highlighted notable advancements in military spouse hiring and <u>gave</u> <u>actionable items</u> to the military community and stakeholders.

Why it matters: The unemployment crisis in the military spouse community that has been exacerbated by the global pandemic. With a 38% unemployment rate, military spouses remain an untapped talent source for American businesses.

- A panel with U.S. Rep. Joe Wilson (R-S.C.) and U.S. Sen. - The Military Spouse Research Collective (MSERC), which brings together stakeholders to build a common foundation for how to approach military spouse employment research, was also announced at the summit.
