William Lockwood Benet, Vice Chairman of Foundation for Puerto Rico, is a financial and development strategy executive. He founded Lockwood Financial Advisors Corp. in 1993 and Generans Bioventures in 2000. During 2011 he conducted due diligence with McKinsey on the two largest private investments in PR: the \$1.4 BN private concession of PR-22/5 highways for winning group Abertis-Goldman Sachs and the \$525M First BanCorp capital raise by Thomas H. Lee Partners, L.P., Oaktree Capital Management, L.P. and other investors. Besides client investment and strategy services, he currently works on Basel III, macro prudential and US financial regulation, reform of PR fiscal management and private sector development institutions and commercialization of patents. He is a former President of the Government Development Bank for PR, where he worked for 7 of his 11 years in government, and a former Chairman of Grupo Guayacan, the private equity and entrepreneurship group. Since 2006 he attends annual IMF and World Bank meetings as PR civil society representative. He is a graduate of Brown University and the Institute of Development Studies at the University of Sussex.
