Hope everyone is well; EPA Region 2, which services New Jersey, New York, Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and eight Indian Nations, released a request for applications (RFA) for the latest sustainable materials management (SMM) grant in May. The grant is for an award of \$85k for 1-3 applicants and will be **closing this Friday**.

There are a variety of sustainable materials management related grants that currently open with EPA, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), and more. Also, EPA's Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) Phase I Solicitation was just announced today and has a topic dedicated to sustainable materials management.
